DEMOCRACY AND CIVIL SOCIETY

The Foundation supports efforts that promote a just, inclusive, sustainable society. It supports full participation of all races, genders, and underserved populations in our voting process. It supports removing dark money from politics.

MEDIA

SUSTAINABLE ITHACA

SCHOOL FOOD AND NUTRITION

The vision for the School Food and Nutrition Special Project area is that all Tompkins County residents will have adequate nutritional security to support their health, growth, and well-being. In particular, the Park Foundation has set a goal of ensuring that every student in Tompkins County has access to and is choosing to eat nutritious and appealing food in school.
